<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>The Fuenmayor-Tresses twinning project is a collaborative initiative designed to strengthen cultural and agricultural ties between the town of Fuenmayor, Spain, and Tresses, France.</p> <p>The aim of this project is to promote knowledge exchange, particularly focusing on sustainable vineyard practices, as both regions share a deep-rooted history in winemaking. This event was part of a broader effort to address pressing issues such as climate change,</p>			

which significantly impacts vineyard agriculture in both countries. The event gathered vineyard agriculturists from France and Spain, fostering collaboration and discussion around solutions for the challenges they face.

Event Summary:

The event took place on the 20th, 21st, and 22nd of September 2024 in Fuenmayor, featuring a series of activities designed for vineyard agriculturists from France and Spain.

A total of 56 French guests and 55 participants from Spain were invited.

Day 1:

Upon arrival, a welcome meeting was hosted for the Tresse guests by the mayor and local authorities. Attendees were provided with an itinerary for the 3-day event and received an explanatory document addressing the issue of climate change and its effect on vineyards.

Day 2:

The second day featured a radio debate on climate change with participation from an expert professional who offered solutions, alongside farmers from both France and Spain. Additionally, a photography exhibition was organized, showcasing comparative images of vineyards from the past and present.

Day 3:

On the final day, a tour of the vineyards was conducted, focusing on how the vines interact with the environment and the ongoing changes affecting them due to climate shifts.

France and Spain worked closely together during these activities, targeting vineyard farmers from both nations. Informational brochures were distributed, outlining the issue of climate change and its specific impacts on vineyards.

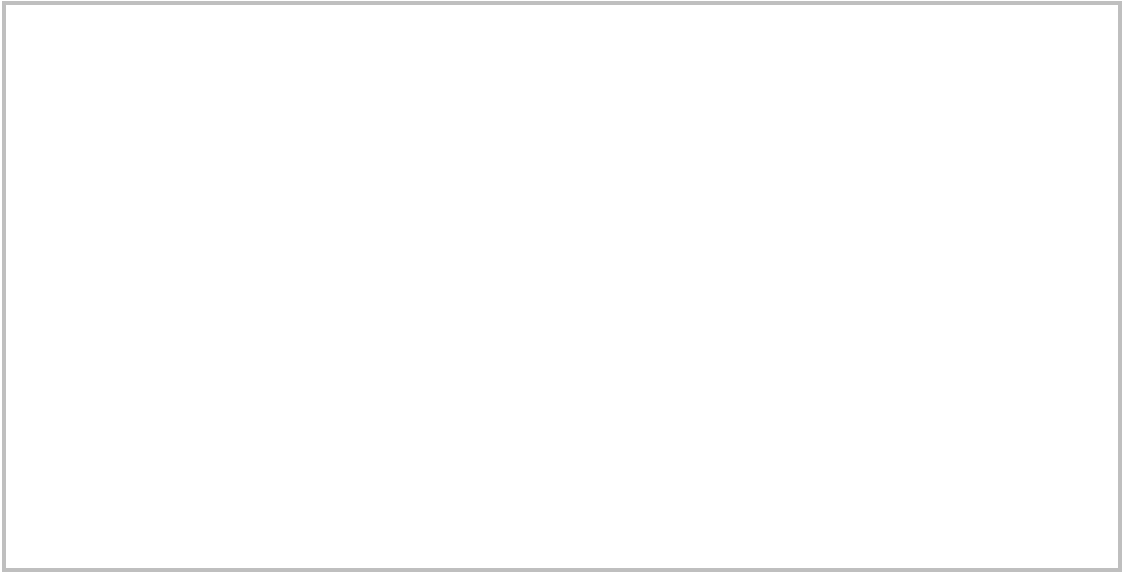
